Rules, Regulations, and Guidelines

Payment and Fees

- Single Routine (Traditional or GameDay Only) Registration: \$175.00
- Exhibition: \$75.00
- Traditional Routine and Game Day Combination: \$275.00
- Spectator Fees: Age 6 and up \$10.00. Age 5 and under are FREE.

Competition Schedule

- DWHS Booster volunteers will determine the competition schedule under the supervision of the DWHS Cheer coaches.
- We reserve the right to combine or divide divisions if necessary.

Conduct and Sportsmanship

- No athletes/coaches from other programs are allowed in the warm-up areas until assigned times and accompanied by Whippet Invitational personnel.
- Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their program members, including all coaches, parents, fans, and participants. No food or drinks allowed in the auditorium.
- Personal music devices must be kept at a low volume in hallways and the auditorium.
- All program members are expected to conduct themselves in a respectful manner.
- Failure to do so may result in removal from the competition.

Safety & Medical Services

- No Jewelry will be permitted.
- Spirit tattoos are acceptable.
- Spotters will be provided, but you may opt-out from using them.
- An athletic trainer and/or ambulatory services will be available in case of emergency.
- AACCA safety guidelines will be followed (please visit www.aacca.org for more information).

Liability

- Cheerleaders will not be permitted to participate without a medical waiver on file after squad check-in.
- Participants assume all risk and responsibility. Competition organizers and Downingtown Area
 School District are not responsible for any injury to participants.
- Competition organizers are not responsible for lost or stolen personal belongings.

Awards and Judging

- Awards will be determined by the number of teams in each division.
- Judges will be impartial and qualified to evaluate all divisions represented.
- Decisions made by the judging panel are final. No participant, coach, parent, or fan will be permitted to question or approach a judge in response to score sheet decisions.

Routine Structure, Music, and Time Limits

- Music is expected to be in good taste and contain no foul language
- Dance teams will perform on the wood basketball court. Cheer teams will perform on a standard 9-panel foam mat surface.
- Coaches (or someone from your organization) will be expected to start and stop your own music.
- Timing will begin with the first official movement, voice, or the first note/beat of music.
- Total routine length shall be no more than 2 minutes and 30 seconds for Traditional and 3 minutes for Gameday
- The music portion of any school or recreational division traditional routine may not exceed 1 minute and 30 seconds.
- All performances must begin with each participant having at least one foot on the floor. Both feet leaving the floor will constitute the beginning of the timed routine.
- If a routine is interrupted by musical equipment failure, the team will be permitted to pick up the routine from the point at which the disruption occurred.
- In case of injury, the team may continue with the routine, come off the mat and regroup, or withdraw from the competition. Competition officials reserve the right to stop a routine in the case of injury.

Concession and Product Vendors

- No outside food or drink will be permitted in the school. No food or drink of any kind will be permitted inside the performance gym and auditorium.
- Concessions will be available throughout the day in the cafeteria.
- Various vendors will be present throughout the day.
- Competition t-shirts will be sold the day of the competition.
